

The Botanical Garden:

The Botanical Garden was established in 1413 H in the University Campus containing more than 100 of wild kinds, farm ponds, greenhouses, a water basin, and a warehouse for seeds.

The Botanical Garden, in the Department of Botany and Microbiology, aims at identifying various types of the Kingdom's plants; edible, medical, pastoral, aromatic, and toxic. The Botanical Garden also aims at preserving desert plants threatened with extinction, and allowing researchers and specialists to obtain plant samples and different seeds for



various specialized scientific research throughout the year. It may be not known to some people that wild plants can be used as accessories to beautify the gardens and public parks in view of the advantages of those plants given their multiple forms, beautiful flowers and the pleasant scent. Furthermore, these plants are suited to the environmental conditions of the Kingdom which other plants cannot tolerate.
